

ILE GOLF COMMITTEE MEETING  
6-16-09 3:00 P.M.

Also in attendance: Rick Robinson, Janice Massoti, Susan Sohni

Minutes of May 12 meeting approved as read.

Rick reported that the water usage permit is approved and in use, however, the paper work is not in hand as yet.

Janice brought up the new out of bounds stakes for the par three. They are very close the #9 cart path by the green. Pat explained the incorrect placement as a line-up problem; they can be moved and should be fine. There is an extra stake on #10 that should also be checked. The line between #6 and #14 was also questioned. It is necessary regarding the safety of the #6 tee box. Norm and another committee member will go out and check if any are in error and authorize movement where necessary. A few stakes are red and should be changed to yellow. These also will be checked and changed.

The money for sprigs is not being donated as originally discussed. We need to get the word out that donations are imperative.

Janice volunteered to come up with a letter of request to be sent out to all members for donations regarding the course with a minimum of \$20.

Norm questions the "Hole Sign Sales". Is it time to resign/sale the holes? It is done every 3 yrs.. The next yr. to be done is 2010. Money is collected and signs made June-October. Last time was 2007.

Anita presented information regarding the shooting of a nursing Sand Hill crane on the golf course. She has been approached regarding possible punishment of person involved. Such action would be up to the Board of Directors and not this committee.

Bubba, Mike's assistant, is taking over the management duties of the golf course. Greens person for Oakwood can buy chemicals and mix on an hourly basis when necessary until Bubba can be licensed.

Susan checked, and at present time, \$2100 of special assessment money has been donated back to ILE and named for Golf course. In addition to paying for sprigs, additional top dressing is needed for the greens. These must be in shape by September in order to attract group play scouts for upcoming season. Hopefully, the \$2100 and any donations as result of letter to be sent out will put us inline and ready for September.
