I. L. E. GOLF RULES AND SELECTED POLICIES

Golf is a sport in which etiquette is of paramount importance. Conformity to rules and regulations is mandatory if members and their guests are to have maximum enjoyment.

The responsibility of all golfers begins on the first tee and continues through the 18th green. Consideration of others is the most important rule of golf. This involves first: the players ahead who can be injured or annoyed by balls driven before the preceding players are out of range and second: avoiding slow play which would hold up the players behind you.

1. **All players must register at the Pro Shop prior to play and get a receipt.** This may be critical if someone needs to find you for an emergency.
2. Proper golf attire is expected at all times whether on the course, range or practice area.
3. Each player must have his or her own golf clubs and golf bag with a minimum of 5 clubs including a putter.
4. Only two people are permitted to ride in a golf cart at any time, no over sized tires allowed.
5. All singles, twosomes and threesomes are asked to combine to foursomes whenever possible. The Pro Shop reserves the right to require foursomes during busy times.
6. Fivesomes are only allowed from May 1 - September 30th and only after 10:00 a.m. with the **permission of the Pro Shop.**
7. If a group fails to keep its place on the course and losses more than one clear hole on the players in front, that group **must** invite the group behind them to play through.
8. Practice must be confined to the designated areas only.
9. Spending more than 5 minutes looking for a lost ball is prohibited.
10. Starting play from any tee other than 1 or 10 is prohibited except for Shotgun starts and late afternoons when the course is open.
11. Groups pausing too long between nines (5 mins.) will automatically lose their turn.
12. Cart drivers **must** be at least 15 years old.
13. Children under the age of 5 are not allowed on the course and children under the age of 12 are not permitted to play on the golf course or practice range unless accompanied by an adult.

14. No glass containers allowed on course and any metal cap is extremely harmful to the precision settings of the mower blades.

15. No dogs allowed on course.

16. No carts shall go beyond the marked areas (painted, roped or signed), within 50 feet of the greens, or on the slopes of tees boxes or greens. No carts are to be driven, pulled or left in any area that would obstruct the play of another golfer or do damage to the course. Always park your cart even with or beyond the flag on the cart path to speed up play.

** Handicapped may approach from the side toward the rear never from the front and not closer than 20 ft of greens collar.

17. Please keep carts on paths where provided and practice the 90 degree rule.

18. Please repair ball marks, fill divots with sand and rake bunkers.

19. Must be a Golf Member to join the driving range. You may not give range balls to anyone. Your friends and family are required to purchase balls by the bucket. No one is allowed to go on the range and pick up balls without permission of the Pro Shop.

20. When the Pro Shop is open the course is a business. No walking, bicycle's, fishing or other activities that could result in injury or slow play.

21. Rangers will be required to strictly enforce I.L.E. golf course policies. Members need to set the example of respecting our course. Anyone receiving three warnings could be ejected from the golf course.

22. I.L.E. Golf Rules Sheet will be included with subsequent Membership Applications and your signature for membership will be your acknowledgment of receiving course rules and policies.
